Healthy Hunger Free Kids Act

First Lady Michelle Obama and Agriculture Secretary Tom Vilsack unveiled new standards for school meals that will result in healthier meals for kids across the nation. The new meal requirements will raise standards for the first time in more than fifteen years and improve the health and nutrition of nearly 32 million kids that participate in school meal programs every school day. The healthier meal requirements are a key component of the Healthy, Hunger-Free Kids Act, which was championed by the First Lady as part of her *Let's Move!* campaign and signed into law by President Obama.

This legislation calls for increases in the amount of healthy fresh foods served in schools, such as an increase in fruits and vegetables. The focus of this Act is to provide children with the tools they need to make healthy food choices at school and at home. The Act calls for reduced sodium and reduced calorie items. It also calls for more whole grains, fruit and vegetables and healthier items in vending machines. The legislation also requires meal prices to be in line with federal subsidies for students who receive Free and Reduced Price Meals. The increases in opportunity for students to select more nutrient dense meals are worth the financial investment.
